The dragons were heartened to learn about new business leadership-driven policies embracing proactive duty of care for the health of their employees. Geoff Hoad at Optus reported that his company had managed to encourage over 70% of its employees to participate in the national Bowel Testing campaign. Dragon Claw's Susan Hughes shared her personal workers compensation experience where she faced an adversarial workplace culture. Susan said 'I was delighted to learn that Ramsay Health now has an executive representative regularly attending their return-towork meetings with injured employees and coordinators.' 'It is great to hear that Australian business health leaders are working on proactive policies to empower their workers to self-care, which is what Dragon Claw is all about.
